One of every 11 mortgage holders in the U.S. is now delinquent on their payments or in foreclosure. The crisis has now spread beyond the subprime mortgage disaster to those with regular interest loans. Michigan is one of the worst states in the country for the number and rate of home foreclosures. Every city, town and area in our state is affected. Foreclosures, evictions, blight, abandoned and vandalized homes, devastated communities – enough is enough! With high unemployment, lowered wages and benefits, soaring gas, fuel and food prices – the people demand relief. **Only a mass outpouring of people from all around Michigan will force the State Legislature to pass SB-1306, Sen. Hansen Clarke's bill for a 2-year moratorium to stop foreclosures.** Call your state representative and senator and urge them to pass SB-1306. This law will delay the sheriff's sale for two years or extend the redemption period from six months to two years, allowing people to stay in their homes and make reasonable payments based in part on their income. Organize your friends and family, coworkers, classmates, neighbors, union and church members and everyone you know to march on Lansing on September 17.
